Arguments heard today and file perused.


Through this succession petition, the petitioners seek issuance of succession certificate in respect of the debt / movable legacy / amount (*fully described in the statement of PW.1*) of deceased **Gulzar Khan**.

The respondent i.e. Public at large was summoned through publication of Court notice in daily newspaper but no one from the public appeared before the Court, hence, placed ex-parte. Ex-parte evidence of the petitioners recorded and closed.

According to the ex-parte evidence of the petitioners coupled with the report of process serving agency and arguments of learned counsel, petitioners are prima facie the legal heirs of the deceased and are entitled to the grant of succession certificate. There is nothing in rebuttal; hence, in the absence of any rebuttal, petition in hand is accepted, petitioners are declared as the legal heirs of the deceased. Succession certificate be issued accordingly to them subject to furnishing of surety bonds to the tune of Rs. 700,000/- (Seven Hundred Thousand Rupees) with two local and reliable sureties, each in the like amount satisfaction of this Court.
