The complainant namely; Sajidullah s/o Ali Mas Khan had reported the occurrence to the local police on 27.06.2023 at about 12:30 hours that his sister namely; Sadiqa Bibi w/o Shahjahan has allegedly committed suicide at her matrimonial abode. Accordingly, proceedings u/s 174 of the Cr.PC were initiated however at later stage complainant charged her husband, brother-in-law and father-in-law/present accused/petitioner for her murder.</p> <p>3. 		<p>and false implication for charging him in the instant case however an altercation is reported between the spouses, brother-in-law and father-in-law/accused/petitioner. Moreover, the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case are not attracting to the benefit of accused/petitioner. The deceased has died inside the house where the present accused/petitioner was also residing. Therefore, without commenting on merits of the case; lest it would be detrimental to the case of either party, I am of the view, that the case of the accused/petitioner is not fit for the grant of extraordinary concession of pre-arrest bail. Resultantly, the petition is dismissed. The ad-interim pre-arrest bail already allowed to the accused/petitioner stands recalled.</p> <p>4.
