


Petitioner namely; Parvez s/o Muhammad Shareef r/o Ramdarra Tehsil Ghazi, seeks issuance of directions to the respondent/SHO Police Station Ghazi to register a criminal case against respondents namely; 1. Muhammad Rafique s/o Said Ahmad 2. Abdul Samad s/o Muhammad Ishtiaq 3. Muhammad Israr s/o Abdul Manan 4. Mushtaq s/o Muhammad Ameen 5. Babar s/o Mushtaq Residents of Ramdarra Tehsil Ghazi District Haripur, under relevant sections of law for the commission of offence. 3. Petitioner vide Mad No. 17 dated 05.07.2023 contends that on the even date at about 14:20 hours reported to the local police that while he was at his house, he got knowledge that the respondents named above have started construction at disputed property despite injunctive orders of court; that upon reaching there he tried to restrain them however respondents started swearing him and then he came under the kicks and fists of respondent party. 	 <p>12/08/23</p>	<p>Mushtaq hit him with shovel due to which he sustained injuries on forehead while Mushtaq and others extended stick blows etc. and the matter was witnessed by residents of the locality. He further contended that the respondents have snatched his mobile phone on which he had recorded the entire scuffle; that the local police has not lodged FIR against the respondents despite the commission of cognizable offences therefore he lodged an application before District Police Officer (DPO) on 12.07.2023 but in vain, hence the instant petition.</p> <p>4. Comments were requisitioned and received on 07.08.2023. SHO confirmed the arrival of the petitioner to the PS and contends that his stance was duly incorporated vide Mad No. 17 dated 05.07.2023; that his inquest report was prepared and then his medical examination at THQ Ghazi was conducted in which injuries were stated to be <i>simple</i> in nature; that there is a dispute over joint property due to which every so often they approach the local police and other institutions over petty matters.</p> <p>5. Arguments heard and record perused. Record reflects that after report vide Mad No. 17 dated 05.07.2023 when the petitioner was referred to medical examination the same were opined to be simple injuries on sagittal and scapular region which did not constitute</p>
